SUBMISSION INFORMATION

The Scott O'Dell Award is given for a distinguished work of historical fiction. To be eligible a book must be published by a U.S. publisher; the setting must be South, Central or North America; and the author must be a U.S. citizen. Books published during each calendar year are eligible for the following year's award.

Hazel Rochman, Contributing Editor of YA Books for ALA's *Booklist*, is the committee chair. She succeeds the late Zena Sutherland who served as chair from the inception of the award. The two other members of the committee are Ann Carlson, English and Fine Arts Librarian at Oak Park and River Forest High School, Oak Park, IL, and Roger Sutton, Editor-in-Chief of *The Horn Book* (Boston, MA).

Send Title Information.

Books may be submitted throughout the year. Send the following information for each title you wish to bring to the attention of the committee to Hazel Rochman (see address below; submission information may accompany books).

Indicate: O'Dell Award, Book Title (include subtitle if there is one),
Author, Publisher.

Name, telephone number, and e-mail address of the publishing house contact.

The committee may consider any eligible book, but publishers' submissions are valuable in bringing books to the attention of the committee.
